

CORONAVIRUS PANDEMIC
Updated 29-7-20

We have been following the advice being given by the Government about how we should respond to the Coronavirus outbreak.

The current advice is:

- All vulnerable people should self-isolate to avoid contracting the virus. Vulnerable people include those over 70, pregnant women and people with underlying health problems.
- Anyone feeling ill, or with symptoms of fever and a new cough should self-isolate for 14 days, along with anyone in the same household.
- **The Stable Community Cafe** is open on Thursdays and Fridays from 10:00 to 16:30. From August we will be opening on Wednesday afternoons and hope to return to full opening in September.
- We have cancelled all our small group meetings (House groups, WOW etc.) including Stepping Stones.

You should then be connected to the Zoom conference call and you will be able to hear all that is said, and also to speak to people yourself.

The Baptists Together website also contains advice on pastoral visiting, which we should all adhere to, not just the Pastor or Pastoral Team leaders. This will obviously have an effect on our fellowship as it flies in contradiction to the advice in Hebrews that we should "not give up meeting together." (Hebrews 12:25) However, we are also urged to respect and obey our Government and to take sensible precautions to protect ourselves and others in our communities. We will therefore be sending out regular messages to ensure that people feel "connected to the Vine" (John 15), especially those who are isolated. Perhaps the most obvious responses are to pray for one another, and to use the telephone to contact people in the fellowship you haven't seen for a while, to make sure they feel included and loved.
